**WHEREAS**, pollinator species such as birds and insects contribute to farming, ranching and food production; and

**WHEREAS**, pollination plays a vital role in national forest and grassland health. Forests and grasslands provide fish and wildlife habitat as well as recreational and economic opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, pollinator species help maintain healthy, biodiverse ecosystems; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Wyoming has managed wildlife habitats and state lands, forests and grasslands, for decades; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Wyoming provides conservation assistance to protect pollinators and maintain pollinator habitats on working lands and public lands.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, MATTHEW H. MEAD**, Governor of the State of Wyoming, do hereby proclaim June 15 – 21, 2015 as
